Required Documents

The following will need to be submitted as part of a CU-CLUBBS application:

For the Child Applicant:

- □ 1) A valid form of identification, such as:
 - Valid passport, licence, government or school ID card
 - If no ID, a birth certificate will be accepted.
- □ 2) Proof of address, such as:
 - A utility bill tied to your home with a signed letter from the person who lives with you in the same residence.
- □ 3) A minimum of \$5.00.

For the Adult Co-Signatory:

- □ 1) A valid form of Government-issued identification, such as:
 - Bermuda passport, driver's licence, voter's card, ID card, Special Person's Card; and
 - If non-Bermudian, proof of residence or employment such as a work permit, property ownership, pension payment or spousal letter.
- □ 2) Confirmation of existing membership as a Bermuda Credit Union account holder.
 - You must be a BCU member with your identification and personal details matching your member information on file.

Upon reaching the age of 18, the Child Applicant will be required to contact the Credit Union and apply for full membership to maintain an account.
